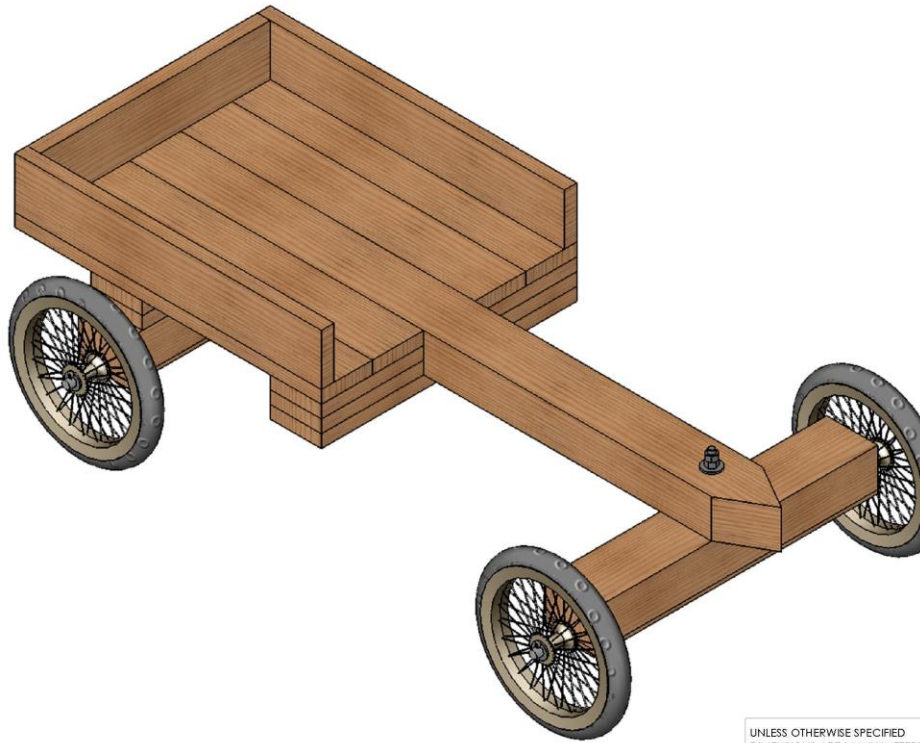
Rationale

Timescale

Rules and regulations

1. The course is a time trial and the amount of runs will be dependent on the amount of entries received. Entries probably capped at – 20 teams
2. £10 per team entry
3. Sponsors logo more than welcome – sponsors cheques made out to Anahilt PTA!!
4. There will be no size limit to the soapbox but it must fit through the gate!!
5. It will be a flat course and will require that the soapbox is pushed (by someone over 16).
6. The course will be marked out and vehicles must stay within the course boundaries.
7. Junior competitors will not be allowed to run the course if the driver and any passengers do not have the required safety equipment – cycle helmet, knee pads, elbow pads.
8. Adults are warned that they should wear the same protective clothing as the Junior driver but for them it is discretionary.
9. Each run will be timed by a time keeper.
10. Teams must have at least one driver (child at school) but can have more or even passengers and one pusher (over 16) .
11. No additional power will be allowed - no pedals, no engines, no sails!! Only manpower allowed from start to finish.
12. The judges decision is final! No appeals allowed!
13. All competitors take part at their own risk.
14. All children under 16 MUST have a parent/guardian signature to take part.
15. Anahilt Primary School, the marshals and organisers take no responsibility for injury or damage to the vehicles or property. Each entrant must accept responsibility for their own actions and understand the possible risks of taking part.
16. Dangerous actions will be penalised and could result in your disqualification.
17. Each competitor must sign the entry form and accept these terms and conditions or they will not be allowed to compete.
18. Entry fees to be paid before 24th May
19. Each vehicle will be given a number for ease of identification in scoring etc.
