

Heart Quilling Card for Valentine's Day

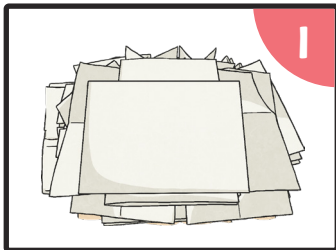
You will need:

- A4 card (any colour)
- Scissors
- A4 Construction paper (reds, whites and pinks)
- White glue
- Glue spatula
- Pencil (or something else to wrap the paper around)
- Heart template for sizing

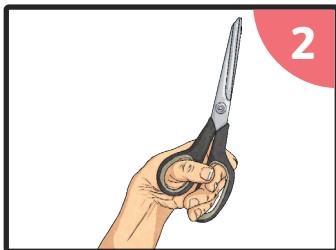


On Valentine's Day, many people choose to give the person they love a card and possibly a present as a token of their love. This card uses your creative skills and would make a lovely gift for a special person.

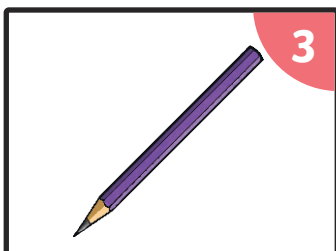
Instructions:



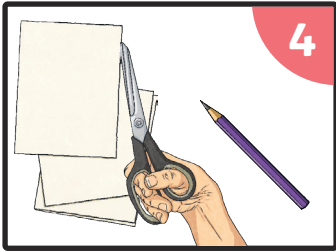
Select a piece of card and fold it in half, short edge to short edge.



Cut various strips of construction paper (long edge or small edge) approximately 1cm wide.

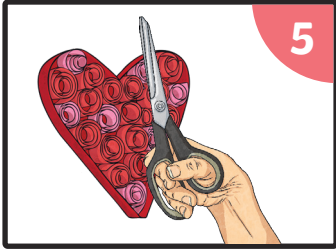


Take a strip and wrap it around the pencil to make a curl. Slide the curl off the pencil and give it a little squeeze to make sure it stays tight.

Repeat with all the strips of paper needed.

For the heart outline, you will need two strips of red construction paper (approximately 15cm long and 1cm wide). Curve one strip on its side around one half of the heart template to get your shape.

Using the spatula, place glue along one edge of the strip and stick it on to the card in the centre.

Repeat steps 5 and 6 with the remaining strip to complete your heart shape.

One by one, spread glue on the bottom of the curls and fill the inside of the heart.

Leave the glue to dry and you now have a fantastic Valentine's Day card.

Alternatives:

- You may wish to use different colours or create a different image, such as a bouquet of flowers.
- Add glitter glue or sequins to make it sparkle.
