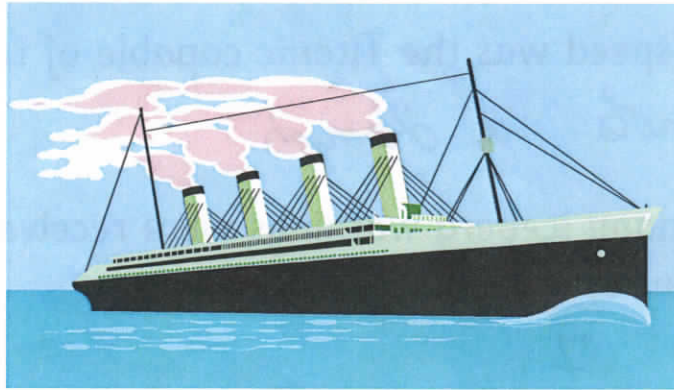

The White Star line

£5 million (Today £255 million)

Wednesday 31st. May, 1911 at 12.15pm

6. Who was

- J Pierpoint Morgan - American Banker + he owned the company → White Star line
- Bruce Ismay - Chairman of The White Star line - he told the captain to accelerate through the icefield, rather than slow down.
- Edward John Smith - Captain - He had previously been the captain of the Olympic and this was to be his last voyage before retirement.
- Thomas Andrews - Ship's designer
- Frederick Fleet - lookout, who 1st. Spotted the iceberg (Survivor)
- Dr. Robert Ballard - Scientist who discovered the wreck of the ship on 1st. Sept. 1985
