

Birthday Celebrations

In January 2020 the Grand Opera House closed to allow for extensive restorations to the building's interior. During this time, the paint, intricate plasterwork and famous elephant head brackets in the auditorium will be repaired and restored. The seats, carpets and curtains will be replaced. The first permanent exhibition (displaying the theatre's rich history) will be installed. On-site facilities and access will also be improved and technology updated to cater for modern touring productions.

The theatre is due to re-open in November in time for the pantomime season and the production of 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. The celebrations for the 125th anniversary of the theatre are due to last all year long.
