Now that we are into our third week of the new school year and back into routine, I wanted to highlight a few important housekeeping matters.

Please note that pupil supervision begins at 8:45am at the gate and in the playground. We kindly ask that no children arrive before this time, as we cannot ensure their safety until our staff are in place.

I am delighted to report that our pupils are looking exceptionally smart in their uniforms. Thank you for your continued support in maintaining our school's high standards of presentation.

A quick update on our SchoolMoney system: dinners can be booked until midnight on Sunday, while Early Birds and Anahilt After School provisions remain open throughout the week. We are pleased with how smoothly this system is operating.

Due to the removal of the composite classes, the P3/P4/P5 staff are working hard to rearrange groupings for reading, spelling and other areas of the curriculum. Whole school pupil data has been reviewed by all staff and informal testing is also taking place over the next few weeks by Mrs Huddleston, our learning support teacher. This information will form the basis of our booster sessions to target underachievement. All assessment data related to your child will be shared with you at the parent teacher meetings in early October.

As part of our School Development Plan we are reviewing and updating policies throughout the year. Later this term, we will be inviting parents to contribute to developing a new Homework policy. This will be in the form of a questionnaire, and of course comments at any time are welcome. Our current policy is available on the school website for your reference.
